Additional Parking Lot at TCMS – John Potts

Mr. Potts informed the Board of an evacuation route from Taylor County Middle School down a gravel path and onto a gravel parking lot to the right of the school. The Board members were pleased with the progress made with the Active Shooter Drill at Grafton High School. Mrs. Garvin had her first experience with the drill and learned a lot.
